Volunteering



Overview

The overall aim of Lanarkshire Carers Centre is to provide a valuable resource to carers, carers' groups, professionals and organisations throughout Lanarkshire. Support to carers is delivered in a variety of locations with our main centre in Hamilton and a second base in Airdrie.

Lanarkshire Carers Centre provides support to carers who without payment, give help and support to a friend, neighbour, or relative who could not manage without their help because of frailty, illness, disability, mental health issues, blood borne viruses or substance misuse. Lanarkshire Carers Centre is committed to the principle of carers as key partners in the provision of care.

Volunteering

In order to complement the work of paid staff the organisation encourages the services of Volunteers interested in contributing their time, skills and experience in a much valued and needed way. Lanarkshire Carers Centre seeks to provide the opportunity for volunteer work to suit different abilities and circumstances. Volunteers are key partners in the success of our organisation.

Training

Training for volunteers is readily available and volunteers are encouraged to take up relevant opportunities to enhance their knowledge and boost confidence in their voluntary work. All new volunteers are required to complete mandatory training.

Volunteers are encouraged to meet regularly to exchange information and build relationships with colleagues.

Interested

Volunteers are required to complete an expression of interest form and meet with our Volunteer Champion for an informal chat to discuss skills, previous experience and what they hope to gain from volunteering.



Volunteers will be required to be a member

of the PVG Scheme. Administered by Disclosure Scotland, this scheme helps ensure that those who have regular contact with children and protected adults through paid and unpaid work do not have a history of harmful behaviour.

Volunteers give their time voluntarily and without charge but voluntary work brings with it a lot of responsibility. Travel expenses will be provided if required.

Volunteers have a responsibility to:

- Be committed
- Be reliable
- Understand the importance of strict confidentiality concerning other people and their circumstances
